

The Mill Meece Pumping Station Preservation Trust Ltd

Conditions of Membership

1. On payment of the relevant subscription fee a member is entitled to twelve months membership. The subscription year commences on the 1st April, members enrolling October onwards will be entitled to one full years membership, subscription renewal being due in the April following the anniversary of enrolment.
2. Members are entitled to free admission on steaming days on production of their membership card.
3. Members will receive copies of Newsletters and Bulletins as issued by the Trust.
4. Members are entitled to attend working and maintenance parties held each weekend throughout the year. Members of working age obtain accident insurance cover under the Trust's insurance policy whilst engaged on Trust business.

There is no obligation on members to attend such working and maintenance parties. However the existence of the Trust depends on volunteers who are prepared to maintain and operate the equipment, administer the Trust's business and to act as guides and marshals on steaming days and other weekends throughout the year when the station is open to the public.

5. Membership ceases on receipt, by the Trust, of a notification of resignation from the member, or on failure to renew the subscription within three calendar months of the date or as notified by the Trust.

Gift Aid
